# Rapper Zamaera claims she was secretly filmed at massage parlour, wants apology from MBSJ officer

A MALAYSIAN artiste is seeking an apology from the Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) officer who allegedly filmed her in secret while she was having a massage at a parlour in 5514.

Rapper Zamaera, whose real name is Sharifah Zamaera Sved Zafilen Al Edros, also wants MBSJ to issue a statement on the standard operating procedure (SOP) for operations at such establishments, and that they do not condone the actions of its officer

In an Instagram post, Zamaera claimed that one of the MBSI officers had filmed her naked from behind, while she was getting a massage in a room covered by curtains on Wednesday.

Zamaera said she saw some light come through from the back, and saw a man in sunglasses poking his head through the curtains to film her using a handphone.

"I was lying on my tummy with my face on one side, and only had a towel covering part of

"I immediately covered myself in a towel and peeped out, only to find many men claiming to be MBSJ officers at the place.

"Some were in uniform and some were in plainclothes," she said.

Later, Zamaera said she confronted them on why she was filmed and one of them denied

"One officer also claimed that it was part of the SOP during a raid to check for illicit

"The officer showed me a video taken at the establishment, which ended with a recording of another female customer that was naked from behind, having a massage in a different room," she said.

Zamaera said she was disgusted by the way the officers had conducted themselves and had filed a police report, as well as a complaint at MBSJ against its officers.

"I feel that my privacy has been violated.

"I do not feel safe as a woman," she said.

Zamaera said she was due for a meeting at MBSJ today on the matter.

MBSJ could not be reached for comments at press time.

# Probe into rapper's claim she was filmed naked by an officer













SUBANG JAYA: A full investigation into claims that an enforcement agency officer had recorded a rapper while she was unclothed during a raid on a massage parlour will be conducted, say the police.

Rapper Zamaera, whose real name is Sharifah Zamaera Syed Zafilen Al Edros, had alleged that she was secretly filmed while she was having a massage at a parlour in SS14

Subang Jaya OCPD Asst Comm Wan Azlan Wan Mamat said police reports were lodged by both Zamaera and a member of the raiding team after the issue went viral.

"Investigations showed that the complainant who was with the raiding team was provoked by the 'suspect', and that she had used her phone to record them (the raiding party) during the raid," said ACP Wan Azlan.

He said both parties subsequently checked the phone that was believed to have been used to record the footage.

"Both the suspect and complainant then inspected the phone of the officer accused of filming her but found no photo or videos of the suspect," he said in a statement vesterday.

ACP Wan Azlan added that Zamaera also refused to comply with orders to provide identification, and that she had complained about the raid being documented by enforcement agency officers.

He said the officers there had explained the standard operating procedure of the raid to

In her report, Zamaera claimed she had been filmed by a Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) officer while naked during a massage.

In an Instagram post, she claimed that one of the MBSJ officers had filmed her naked from behind while she was getting a massage in a room screened off by curtains.

Zamaera said she saw some light coming through from the back and saw a man wearing sunglasses poking his head through the curtains to film her with a cellphone.

In a Facebook post on Thursday, she said she was to meet with MBSJ on Friday to convey her account of the incident.

### Police probe rapper's claim MBSJ officer recorded her while she was semi-naked

KUALA LUMPUR: Police have launched an investigation into allegations by a local female rapper who claimed that a Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) officer secretly recorded her while she was unclothed during a massage session at a centre in Subang Java.

Subang Jaya district police chief Assistant Commissioner Wan Azlan Wan Mamat said the case is being investigated under Section 186 and Section 509 of the Penal Code for obstructing civil servants from carrying out their duties and insulting the modesty of a woman, respectively.

He added that the case is also being investigated under Section 233 of the Communications and Multimedia Act 1998 for the dissemination of footage from the raid conducted by MBSJ.

Wan Azlan said the investigation into the case was launched following reports lodged by an MBSJ officer and the female rapper.

He said the MBSJ officer claimed that he had instructed his raiding party to record videos and take photos as evidence when they raided a beauty and wellness centre in Subang Java at about 6pm on Dec

"Upon inspection, it was found that the premises was operating without a valid business licence from

"During the inspection, the raiding party was provoked by a local woman who refused to provide her identification card and questioned the documentation carried out by the team.

"Preliminary investigations showed that the complainant and his team were provoked by the suspect, who also recorded the team's actions using her mobile phone," Wan Azlan said in a statement today.

He said the MBSJ officer and the suspect then reviewed the footage on the team members' devices and found no images or videos of the suspect.

The MBSJ officer, he said, also explained to the suspect that the raid was conducted in accordance with the standard operating procedures (SOPs) set out under the MBSJ Beauty and Health Care Centre 2013

"The MBSJ officer lodged a police report regarding the clip of the raid, which had been circulated on

"The suspect, in turn, filed a police report claiming that the raiding party recorded footage of her without clothes during a massage," he added.

Wan Azlan also urged anyone with additional information to come forward and assist in the investigation by contacting the Subang Jaya district police headquarters at 03-78627100 or the investigating officer, Inspector Fadizah Ajamain, at 019-8582166.

The Rakyat Post reported yesterday that the female rapper claimed that an MBSJ officer had secretly recorded her while she was unclothed during a massage session at a parlour in SS14, Subang Jaya.

In a series of social media posts on X, the rapper alleged that she heard male voices about 15 minutes into her massage at the centre

The rapper further claimed that an officer had recorded her while she was unclothed. Unhappy with the situation, she confronted the raiding party and asked who had recorded her.

She claimed that she was told by one of the officers that recording was part of MBSJ's SOP.

(八打灵再也6日讯) 本地嘻哈歌手扎米拉 (Zamaera) 日前到梳邦SS14的一家按摩院按 摩,期间遇到梳邦再也市政厅(MBSJ)的执法人员突击检查,她声称,执法人员在没有表 明自己身份的情况下,打开她按摩的帘子,并拿着手机拍下她赤裸的样子,让她感到震惊。

她在社媒Instagram上发布视频,叙述整个事发经过。

她透露,周三(4日)下午5时30分左右,她独自前往一家新开的按摩院按摩。按摩期间,她 突然听到大厅传来男人嘈杂的声音。

她说,过后有一名男子打开她的帘子,并拿着手机对着她拍摄,随即她穿上衣服,出去直看 才知道梳邦再也市政厅的执法人员突击检查。

她表示,当时毛巾在她的屁股下的位置,所以她认为,该男执法人员一定拍到她的股沟。

扎米拉对官员侵犯她的隐私感到愤怒,质问执法人员为何侵犯她的隐私,拍摄她赤裸的样

一名执法人员突然开口,对扎米拉指责他们的行为不当感到愤怒。"准在做不恰当的事情? 我不知道这里发生了什么猥亵的事情。

然后,扎米拉质疑突击搜查的标准操作程序(SOP),声称这些执法人员没有表明自己的身 份就打开她的帘子。

"你们的SOP是让你们不声不响地走进去,悄悄拉开女顾客的帘子,然后没有表明身份,就 拍摄她们吗?这就是你们的SOP吗?"

该执法人员回答说: "是的,这是我们老板给我们的SOP"。

扎米拉要求拍摄她和其他女顾客的执法人员站出来并道歉,否则她会报警或采取法律行动, 但是, 最后没有人站出来。

扎米拉感到不满,她打算向警方报案,并试图离开,但被执法人员拦住。其中一名执法人员 要求她出示身份证进行记录,这再次使事态升级。

扎米拉向该执法人员表示,她不必向他们提供身份证,因为他们不是警察。

随后,她前往SS17警察局报案。报案后,她按照警察的指示,前往梳邦再也警区总部进行后 续调查。



扎米拉日前到梳邦一按摩院按摩时,说 到梳邦再也市政厅执法人员突击检查。

扎米拉说,SS17警局的警察告诉她,MBSJ执法人员的做法是错误的,让她感到很欣慰。

然而,她表示,梳邦再也警区总部的一名警察却质疑她指控执法人员拍了她隐私部位的说法

尽管如此,扎米拉说,警察还是接受她的报案,帮她录了口供。

扎米拉在视频的最后说,她按照警察的指示,还前往梳邦再也市政厅一趟。

她说,梳邦再也市政厅的官员承认,发生在她身上的事情是错误的,并要求她今天(6日)去 见他的上司。

她还在视频中说,她希望梳邦再也市政厅发表声明,说明他们的官员在这次行动中存在不当 行为,他们这样做是错误的。

"我希望负责的官员或与我交谈的官员,为官员滥用职权道歉,他们的行为不应得到宽 恕。'

#### 嘻哈女歌手指控按摩被拍摄 执法员强调未拍不雅视频



(八打灵再也7日讯) 随着本地嘻哈歌手扎米拉<mark>报案</mark>指控遭梳邦再也市政厅 (MBSJ) 的执法 人员用手机拍下<mark>按摩</mark>时赤裸的画面,一名执法官员已反报案并驳斥指控,强调同僚未拍到任 何不雅视频或照片,以及突击行动遵循标准作业程序 (SOP)。

梳邦再也警区主任旺阿兹兰助理总监今早发文告指出,警方已接获一名MBSJ官员的投报,指于本周三(4日)傍晚6时与同僚突击首邦市某间按摩院,指示同僚检查营业执照,以及拍摄与按摩相关的视频和照片作为证据。

他说,经过检查,事主等人发现该按摩院并没有营业执照,违反了2013年(梳邦再也市议 会)保健中心与美容中心条规。

"事主等人随后遭一名顾客挑衅并拒绝出示大马卡,对方还质疑他们的拍摄之举,对方也使用手机拍摄事主等人执勤的画面。"

他说,事主随后陪同该名顾客检查负责拍视频和照片的同僚手机,但未发现任何不当拍摄证据,也有向顾客解释突击行动是按照SOP执行。

"事主已就突击行动被散播至网络一事报案,同时该名顾客也指控MBSJ官员拍摄她在按摩时赤裸的视频而报案。"

他说,警方目前援引刑事法典第186(妨碍公务员执行任务)和第509(蓄意侮辱他人)条文,以及1998年通讯及多媒体法令第233(不当使用网络设备或服务散播假消息)条文,全面调查双方的投报。

他呼吁知情者致电查案官法蒂菈警长(019-858 2166),或梳邦再也警区总部行动室 (03-7862 7100),以提供相关线索。

扎米拉日前在Instagram上发布视频,称MBSJ执法人员在未表明身份的情况下,打开她在按摩房的帘子并用手机拍摄,并认为对方拍到了她没穿衣服、毛巾在屁股下方的画面。

她质疑执法人员的行为,在场的一名官员回应称"谁在做不雅 (tidak senonoh) 的事情?我不知道这里发生了什么不雅的事情"。

扎米拉欲离开时被要求出示大马卡,她基于执法人员非警察而拒绝提供;她事后已向警方报案,并向MBSJ投诉此事件。

# MBSJ Officer Accused Of Filming Local Rapper Zamaera At Massage Parlour

Zamaera highlighted the absence of a female officer, asking why there wasn't one to handle a case involving a woman if recording was part of their SOP.

Local rapper Sharifah Zamaera Syed Zafelin Al Edros, better known as Zamaera, recently accused a Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) officer of secretly recording her while she was unclothed during a massage session at Chiang Thai massage parlour in SS14, Subang Jaya.

In a series of posts on social media platform X (formerly Twitter) yesterday (5 December), Zamaera detailed the alleged incident which, according to her, happened around 5:30pm.

She had visited the new parlour to try out their services, noting that the masseuses there were very nice to her.



So yesterday at around 5.30pm, I went to a new massage parlour in SS14 by the name of "Chiang Thai". The masseurs were all females and they were super nice to me and put me in room number 7.


According to her, after about 15 minutes into her massage, she heard male voices speaking in Malay.

"They were making so much noise, I was honestly tempted to shush them but I wanted to relax and feel stress-free as we all do when getting a freaking massage," she said.

The rapper claimed that an officer had recorded her while she was unclothed.

She claimed that when she confronted them asking who had recorded her, one of the officers allegedly justified the act saying recording was part of the MBSJ's standard operating procedures.

"As MBSJ officers, you enter a premises that is clearly for men and women, you must announce your presence," she said in the X post.

Through an <u>instagram video</u> she posted yesterday, she recounted the entire incident as well, in even more detail.

Zamaera explained that she overheard one of them asking "Guy or girl?" repeatedly just outside her room, which was covered by a curtain.

At some point during her massage, she said she noticed some light leaking into her room. Since she was lying face down on the massage bed, she turned around to check and saw a man holding a phone camera aimed right at her exposed body.

Moments later, after she had gotten dressed, Zamaera confronted the officers and asked for the perpetrator to come forward.

Although the officers did take videos of the premises, the recording of Zamaera was not found.

At press time, the council has yet to issue a statement on this allegation.

# Rapper Zamaera accuses MBSJ officer of filming her at massage parlour

PETALING JAYA: Local rapper Sharifah Zamaera Al Edros Syed Zafilen has accused a Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) officer of secretly recording her while she was undressed during a massage session in SSI4.

In a series of posts on X, the rapper known as Zamaera detailed her ordeal, accusing the officer of entering the establishment and recording a video of her while she was covered only in a towel.

Zamaera said she was in room seven at the Chiang Thai massage parlour when several Malay-speaking men, purportedly MBSJ enforcement officers, entered the premises.

"They were making so much noise," she said, adding that she initially tried to ignore them to enjoy her massage.

However, Zamaera claimed one officer filmed her while she was exposed during the session. When confronted, the officer allegedly justified the recording by saying it was part of MBSJ's standard operating procedures.

"Which part of invading the privacy of a customer by recording them naked is ethical in any way?" she questioned.

Zamaera said the officer later denied the incident, claiming no video evidence existed even though she saw him record her.

She criticised the officers for failing to announce their presence at the establishment, accusing them of behaving unprofessionally.

"If you're entering a massage parlour, you need to make an announcement. Instead, you sneak in and violate someone's privacy."

The rapper called out the authorities, demanding accountability for the alleged misconduct.

It is understood that she has lodged a police report regarding the incident.

FMT has reached out to MBSJ and the police for comments on the matter.

# M'sian Rapper Claims MBSJ Officers Filmed Her While Unclothed During Massage Parlour Raid in Subang





Malaysian rapper, Zamaera, took to her Instagram page to share how officers from the Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) had allegedly filmed her while she was in an unclothed state when they raided a massage parlour in SS14, Subang.

In her video, she shared that she had gone to the new massage parlour alone at around 5:30pm on Wednesday (December 4). After sharing about how she always opts for a female masseuse, she launched into the shocking story.

During her massage session in one of the small rooms in the parlour, she suddenly heard the loud voices of men coming from the lobby area of the outlet.

"They were being loud, they were being rowdy."

Not knowing what was going on, as Zamaera apparently didn't hear the group identify themselves as MBSJ officers, she decided to ignore the voices and carry on with her massage.

#### This is where things went south

While she faced the wall of the room, she sensed that someone had opened the curtain into her massage area, causing her to turn her head to see who it was.

It was then that Zamaera saw an MBSJ officer looking into the room while he had a phone in his hand pointed at her, allegedly filming in her direction.

"Essentially, the towel (used in massages to cover private areas) was already lower than my butt, you could definitely see my booty crack," she explained.

Considering Zamaera's unclothed state, the masseuse told the officer that there were only ladies there and Zameara, herself, scolded the officer for violating her privacy. The commotion caused the officer to flee from the entrance of the massage room.

Angered by the invasion of privacy, Zamaera used a towel to cover herself while she peeped out of the massage room to see what was going on.

"Who took the video?" she yelled to the group at the massage parlour's lobby, where she saw 12 to 15 MBSJ officers, some in uniform and others in plain clothes.

After immediately putting on her clothes, she started recording the scene as she confronted the officers for violating her privacy and filming her in an unclothed state

"I told them, 'I'm Zamaera, I'm a Subang Jaya resident, I was in a massage when suddenly, someone among you filmed me, who was it? I was unclothed;

"I was filming their faces, if you look closely at the footage, you can see all their faces and they didn't want to say anything. They know that they're guilty, they know that they've done something wrong and they didn't want to say anything," she said.

# One of the officers suddenly spoke up, angry that Zamaera was accusing them of

"Who is doing inappropriate things? I didn't know that obscene things were happening here," he said, referring to women being in an unclothed state to receive massages.

She then questioned the SOPs of their raid, alleging that the officers didn't identify themselves as being from MBSJ and did not announce themselves when one of them opened the curtain to her massage

"Do you think the SOP is for you to walk in unannounced, quietly open the curtains of female customers and film them without saying who you are? Is that your SOPs?" she asked, to which the officer said, "Yes, that's our SOP from our boss "

#### Not knowing where to go from there, she called her father who gave her advice

Having calmed down, Zamaera approached the same officer she had argued with and told him she wanted to settle things in a peaceful manner.

She asked that the officer who filmed her and other customers (there was another female customer an elderly woman, who had also been filmed) reveal himself and apologise if they did not want her to make a police report or take this issue to court. But, no one stepped up.

Suddenly, a different officer approached Zamaera to show her one of the videos the officers had filmed, which she attempted to AirDrop to herself but couldn't due to the officer's phone setting while she

As Zamaera described it, the video showed the officers entering the massage parlour without identifying themselves and the elderly woman in an unclothed state in her massage room before it cut off abruptly.

"He said to me, 'Hah, where? Did you see yourself being filmed?', and I said, 'No, the video of me is not

They went back and forth about this, and Zamaera attempted to record the video that was playing on the officer's phone, but the officer prevented it.

#### The officers allegedly tried to stop her from leaving

Unhappy with how things were going. Zamaera said she was going to make a police report and attempted to leave but was stopped by the officers.

One of the officers asked for her IC to record it, which once again escalated things.

Zamaera pointed out to the officer that she didn't have to provide them with her IC as they were not police officers.

"We can prosecute you for not letting us do our jobs," the officer responded.

She then told them that if they wanted to record her IC, they could follow her to the nearby police station and do it there

"I literally just walked. I said 'I'm going to make a police report right now, you can follow me if you want to', and none of them stopped me," she said.

#### A police report was lodged

She then went to the SS17 police station to make a report. After doing so, she immediately made her way to the Subang Jaya District Police Station Headquarters for a follow-up as instructed by the SS17 police officers

Zamaera shared that she felt validated and relieved as the police officers at the SS17 station were understanding and informed her that what the MBSJ officers did was wrong.

However, one officer at the Subang Jaya District Police Station Headquarters did question whether any 'private parts' were filmed.

She explained that the towel covering her buttocks had moved during the massage, hence a portion of her buttocks would be seen in the video. But, the officer ultimately shared his belief that nothing wrong happened as "no private parts were filmed"

> "It's unethical, it's disgusting. What if it was your own wife, what if it was your own daughter? Even if it was your sons or your husbands? Would you allow something like this to happen?"

Thankfully, the other police officers there still recorded her statement and accepted her report on this

Zamaera ended her video by sharing that the police officers told her to visit MBSJ, which she did.

The MBSJ officer she spoke to at the city council allegedly acknowledged that what happened to her was wrong and asked her to come back again to meet their higher-ups, which she did this morning (December 6).



She also shared what she wants MBSJ to do to right this wrong

"I want an issued statement from MBSJ stating that there was misconduct from their officers during this operation, that it was wrong for them to do so. I want the officers in charge or the officers who spoke to me to apologise for misusing their power, misusing their position, and their behaviour should not be condoned," she said.

She also wants MBSJ to list out what their SOPs are during such operations.

She said in one of her posts that she heard the curtain from her room open and when she turned around, she saw a man in sunglasses holding up his phone camera and taking a video of her

"My masseuse kept on saying this is a female room and after saying that when I turned around again, the man was still filming me with his phone.

"I was lying on my tummy with my face on one side and only had a towel covering part of my body.

"I immediately covered myself in a towel and peeped out, only to find many men claiming to be MBSJ officers at the place.

"Some were in uniform and some were in plain clothes," she said.

Palm Grove resident Subhash Kumaran, 60, said it would take just 30 minutes of rain for his house to be flooded.

MOTORISTS driving along MOTORISTS driving along Persiaran Semarak Api in Cyberjaya will soon enjoy the beautiful sight of a thriving padi growing project at Kebun Bandar, as Sepang Municipal Council (MPSepang) plans to extend the fields up to the roadside

roadside.

The initiative was inspired by former MPSepang president Datuk Abd Hamid Hussain, who envisioned offering travellers views of padi, reminiscent of the landscapes in Sekinchan, Sabak Bernam and Kuala Selangor.

What began as a pilot project with one 0.01acre lot

project with one 0.01acre lot early last year has expanded to seven lots, totalling 0.07acres.

Encouraged by the successful harvests, the council is considering using another 0.2ha of wacant land at the edge of the farm, next to the road, to expand the project.

During the harvest last month, Abd Hamid, who is now Klang mayor, said water management was the primary challenge in maintaining the padi plants.

"When there is no rain, the lots dry out, and we need to pump water from a nearby drain.

"During heavy rainfall, the lots get flooded, and we must pump out excess water.

Additionally, there is apple damage to the crops," he said.

"The mayor has vowed to

A letter by Federal Territories of Kuala Lumpur Lands and Mines Office on March 1 ordered the food court's owner to vacate the site following the discontinuation of its operating licence.

Lai said despite the notice, the food court continued to operate.

"We have set precedents in our previous enforcement operations

such as the one at Jalan Sultan.
"If we can enforce in Chinatown, I am sure we can do the same in Desa Sri Hartamas."
In a StarMetro article titled "Locals stew over illegal food court" on Oct 24, it was reported that the food court's operating licence had been terminated by DBKI. due to the lack of a building permit and poor hygiene conditions.
The food court reportedly did not have proper public health infrastructure such as grease traps, filtration and drainage systems.

systems.

table, manufacture and table about the food court being turned into a multi-storey carpark, with one floor reserved for the existing hawkers, according to the report.

After the report was published, authorities including Indah Water Konsortium (IWK), National Water Services Commission (SPAN) and DBKL visited the food court.

In a statement to StarMetro, IWK said its inspections revealed

that the food court's drainage system was impacted by signifi-cant amounts of fats, oils and

grease (FOG).
"TWK conducted three visits

grease (FOG).

"IWK conducted three visits and clearing services on a manhole near the food court in late October," it said.

However, excessive FOG could still be found in the grease trap, the cleanliness of which, IWK said, was the food court owner's responsibility to maintain.

IWK said it had informed DBKL about the matter and the local authority had since carried out a follow-up visit.

Meanwhile, SPAN, which visited the food court with IWK, found no sewerage issues.

"SPAN also did not detect any bad odour as stated by complainants because only a few stalls were operating in the morning," it said in a statement.

SPAN added that it had requested IWK to continue monitoring the food court.

DBKL has yet to respond to queries.

# Kepong folk tired of risky roads, trees

## Residents in Jalan Lang Kelabu call on DBKL to carry out maintenance

POTHOLES, unpruned trees and poorly maintained play-ground are among issues plagu-ing residents of Jalan Lang

nig residents of Jaian Lang Kelabu in Kepong, Kuala Lumpur. They are calling on Kuala Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) to step up maintenance to prevent acci-dents and ensure residents' safe-

ty.

Keith Sean Arul, 51, said the area's many potholes were posing risks to motorists.

"There is one in front of my house which has been there for decades," he said.

He also pointed to some parts

of the drain around the children's playground that were badly damaged.

He said residents occasionally pooled funds to hire contractors for repairs but this was not sustainable.

Resident K. Thanasekaran, 39, raised concerns about untrimmed bushes around the

untrimmed bushes around the playground.

He said the bushes might collect rainwater and facilitate mosquito proliferation:

"We have lots of mosquitoes in the evening. It's worrying as my mother has contracted dengue before," he said.

Checks by StarMetro also found a handful of unpruned trees pear residents; homes.

trees near residents' homes.

Residents are worried these trees could fall onto people or damage their property.

The playground surface was uneven and covered in algae, posing fall risks.

A pile of rubbish was spotted, too

There were also wooden

and over the drain planks placed over the drain around the playground as a makeshift bridge for residents to access the area.

Kepong community activist Yee Poh Ping said he had sent a letter to DBKL asking for imme-diate maintenance and

diate maintenance and upgrades.

"Residents need a walkway in the playground area. They also need a proper bridge to access the facility," he said.

Earlier this year, DBKL said it would undertake several maintenance and upgrading works in nearby areas, following a

StarMetro report on July 9.

These included building a drain in Suria Homes to solve water-ponding issues and fixing the playground equipment in Taman Sri Segambut.

A study was also carried out to identify the necessary measures to upgrade Taman Usahawan Kepong.

On Dec 6, Yee said DBKL had inspected the site but no repairs had been made.

# DBKL urged to have clear standards for signboards

KUALA Lumpur City Hall (DBKL)

KUALA Lumpur City Hall (DBKL) needs to give more clarity on its signboard ruling, husiness owners in the capital city say.

Persatuan Peniaga & Penjaja Jalan Alor secretary Simon Ang, when contacted, agreed that while using Bahasa Malaysia on signboards was important, it might not make a difference to businesses in tourist areas.

"Some businesses in tourist spots mainly target international tourists who may not understand the language.

"Including Bahasa Malaysia on signboards is sufficient. "DBKL should have engaged with businesses first to discuss

with businesses first to discuss the issue.

"Thorough studies and research need to be done before enforcing," Ang added.

Malaysia Retailers Association council member Ricky Ng said the language ruling would not significantly impact businesses in tourist areas.

"Businesses there will be fine as long as there are other lan-guages on the signboards rele-vant to their target customers and tourists," he said.

While it was not an issue for Bahasa Malaysia words to be larger, DBKL should set a clear standard for size differences

standard for size differences between languages, Ng said. "BBKL should also notify business owners of non-compliance and provide a reasonable time-frame, such as 60 days, to rectify their signboards before taking them down," he added. StarMetro reported that DBKL carried out an enforcement operation on Nov 21 across almost all parliamentary constituencies in Kuala Lumpur after the end of seven-day notices which were issued to non-

compliant businesses.

In response to criticism, DBKL said Bahasa Malaysia wordings on business signboards must be larger than words in other languages to uphold its role as Malaysia's national and official languages.

Malaysia's national and official language.

However, City Hall clarified that if a business, association or company name registered under the Registration of Businesses Act 1956, Companies Act 1965 or Societies Act 1966 ontained words not in Bahasa Malaysia, those words need not be translated into the national language. language.

Ng is also battling stage 1 cancer and recently underwent kidney surgery, which forced him to take a break from work.

However, when he wanted to resume work on Sept 21, Ng discovered that his usual spot had been occupied by a durian stall. The durian stall operator claimed to have a tenancy agree-

ment with a nearby convenience

store.

StarMetro learnt that the agreement had been terminated, as it required the stall to be located closer to the convenience

Despite this, the durian sellers have continued operating, thus leaving Ng displaced.

"Although I have tried applying many times, DBKL informed

me years ago that I didn't need

a licence.
"But other traders have repeatedly taken over my lot whenever I was away. This has happened four times since 2014.
"My child has just started university and the expenses are a heavy burden, so I need to continue my business to earn a liv-

ing," said Ng, who is his family's sole breadwinner and commutes daily from Sungai Buloh to Jalan

Alor.

He appealed to DBKL to grant him a licence to ensure he had proper documentation to show other traders.

Ng was speaking during a

press conference organised by the Jalan Alor Traders and Hawkers Association.

Association secretary Simon
Ang said the durian operator's
stall had also encroached beyond
a faded yellow line that marked
traders' lots along the road.
"We have highlighted the matter to Bukit Bintang MP Fong Kui
Lun who raised the issue with

the Kuala Lumpur mayor on Oct 17," said Ang. "It has been several weeks since the tenancy agreement was terminated, yet the durian stall continues operating at the

site.
"No action has been taken by

Ang urged DBKL to license traders such as Ng to prevent further disputes, while recommending that the faded yellow lines marking the lots be repainted to provide clear demarcation.

"We found that the cost of renovating schools that were used as PPS was high, especially when classrooms had to be renovated

classrooms had to be renovated as some schools did not have halls," Ahmad Zahid said when met by reporters after the Rural Road project handover ceremony here yesterday.

Previously, National Disaster Management Agency (Nadma) director-general Datuk Khairul Shahril Idrus said the government planned to build nine PPKs nationwide, complete with basic facilities for flood victims.

Ahmad Zahid, who is also National Disaster Management Committee chairman, said 32

Cops' probing into claims by female rapper, MBSJ officer

KUALA LUMPUR: Police have launched investigations into various allegations that surfaced after a Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) team raided a massage parlour in SSI4 recently, where a local female rapper was undergoing a session.

The female rapper claimed that an MBSJ officer had secretly recorded her while she was unclothed.

And the incident is also being investigated for obstructing civil servants from carrying out their duties after the woman allegedly provoked the raiding team and disseminated footage of the raid on social media.

Subang Jaya police chief Assistant Commissioner Wan Azlan Wan Mamat said an MBSJ officer and the female rapper had lodged reports over the incident.

He said the MBSJ officer had instructed his raiding party to record videos and take photos as evidence when they raided a beauty and wellness centre in Subang Jaya at 6pm on Dec 4.

"Upon inspection, it was found that the premises was operating without a licence from MBSJ.
"During the inspection, the raiding party was provoked by a local woman, who refused to provide her identification card and questioned the documentation carried out by the team.

"Preliminary investigations showed that the complainant and his team were provoked by the woman, who also recorded the MBSJ team using her mobile phone," Wan Azlan said yesterday. He said the MBSJ officer and the woman then reviewed the footage on the team members' devices and found no images or videos of the latter.

"The MBSJ officer lodged a police report regarding the clip of the raid, which was circulated on social media by the woman.

"The woman, in turn, filed a police report claiming that the raiding party had recorded her without clothes during a massage," he said.

According to a news portal report, the rapper alleged on X that she heard male voices about 15 minutes into her session.

The rapper further claimed that an officer had recorded her while she was unclothed, Unhappy with the situation, she confronted the raiding party and asked who had recorded her.

# Childcare centres must display registration number

KUCHING: All childcare centres licensed by the Social Welfare Department must display their registration number from Jan 1.

Women, Family and Community Development Minister Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri said the move was necessary to assure parents of the licensing status of childcare centres where their children are placed.

"My ministry is often questioned about unregistered childcare centres.

"So now, we are making it compulsory for childcare centres to display their registration number so that guardians sending their children can know that the centres are registered," she said at a programme with the Sarawak media here on Saturday night.

She said the initiative was among the ministry's main agendas for 2025.

Nancy said other agendas for the upcoming year included rolling out the Autism Learning Fee Assistance initiative and the development of an autism service centre, involving allocations of RMIS million and RM5 million, respectively.

"The prime minister announced this during the 2025 Budget. It is a new initiative aimed at ensuring the welfare of autistic children.

"It is time for the government to provide focused support and early intervention for autistic children without placing them alongside non-autistic children," she said. Bernama

# Pendapatan Boleh Guna Bersih ukuran tepat basmi kemiskinan

Pendapatan Boleh Guna Bersih (NDI) sebagai pengganti Pendapatan Garis Kemiskinan (PGK) untuk mengukur kemiskinan di Malaysia adalah satu langkah signifikan dalam usaha mendapatkan gambaran lebih tepat mengenai kesejahteraan ekonomi ra-

tepat mengenai kesejanteraan ekonomi ra-kyat Malaysia. NDI merujuk kepada jumlah pendapatan boleh digunakan individu atau keluarga se-lepas ditolak semua perbelanjaan wajib se-perti cukai pendapatan, caruman Pertubu-han Keselamatan Sosial (PERKESO), zakat, Kumpulan Wang Simpanan Pekerja (KWSP) dan perbelanjaan asas lain.

dan perbelanjaan asas lain.

Ini memberikan gambaran lebih jelas mengenai jumlah wang benar-benar tersedia bagi individu atau isi rumah untuk perbelanjaan harian serta menyara keperluan hidup.

Penggunaan NDI sebagai pengukur kemiskinan mempunyai beberapa kelebihan berbanding PGK.

Pertama, NDI memberikan gambaran lebih tepat mengenai kesejahteraan ekonomi kerana ia mengenahik lira perbelanjaan wajih perin ditangging mengenai kesejanteriaan ekololim keriani a interngambil kira perbelanjaan wajib perlu ditanggung individu atau keluarga. Ini berbeza dengan PGK hanya menetapkan satu garis pendapatan minimum tanpa mengambil kira perbelanjaan sebenar. Dengan menggunakan NDI, kita dapat menilai kesejahteraan ekonomi dengan lebih baik kerana

ia menunjukkan jumlah pendapatan benar-benar boleh digunakan untuk memenuhi keperluan hidup. Ini membantu mengenal pasti golongan be nar-benar memerlukan bantuan.

Selain itu, NDI lebih dinamik kerana ia boleh

disesuaikan mengikut perubahan dalam kos sara hidup dan perbelanjaan wajib. Ini memastikan pe-ngukuran kemiskinan sentiasa relevan dengan ke-adaan ekonomi semasa.

adaan ekonomi semasa.
Sebagai contoh, jika kos sara hidup meningkat,
NDI akan mengambil kira peningkatan itu dan
memberikan gambaran lebih tepat mengenai kesejahteraan ekonomi rakyat.
Ini berbeza dengan PGK mungkin tidak mengambil kira perubahan dalam kos sara hidup dan
perbelanjaan wajib. Penggunaan NDI sebagai pengukur kemiskinan juga mempunyai implikasi
penting dalam merangka dasar sosial dan ekonomi.

Apabila mendapat gambaran lebih tepat mengenai kesejahteraan ekonomi rakyat, kerajaan dapat merangka dasar sosial dan ekonomi lebih berkesan. Ini termasuk penyaluran bantuan kewangan lebih

Im termasuk penyaluran bantuan kewangan iebih tepat kepada golongan memerlukan dan perancangan program pemulihan ekonomi lebih berkesan. Selain itu, penggunaan NDI juga dapat membantu dalam usaha pembangunan mampan. Berdasarkan gambaran lebih tepat mengenai kesejahteram ekonomi rakyat, kerajaan dapat merancang dan malakanakan program pembangunan lebih dan melaksanakan program pembangunan lebih mampan dan inklusif.

mampan dan inkush.

Ini termasuk usaha mengurangkan jurang pen-dapatan dan meningkatkan kualiti hidup golongan berpendapatan rendah. Sebagai contoh, kerajaan dapat mengenal pasti golongan memerlukan ban-

tuan dalam bidang pendidikan dan kesihatan. Penggunaan NDI juga membolehkan pemanta-uan dan penilaian lebih berkesan terhadap keber-kesanan program bantuan dan pemulihan ekonomi. Ini membantu memastikan sumber diperuntukkan, digunakan dengan optimum dan mencapai matlamat ditetapkan

Bagaimanapun, penggunaan NDI sebagai pengukur kemiskinan juga ada cabaran perlu diatasi. Salah satu cabaran utama adalah pengumpulan data tepat dan menyeluruh mengenai pendapatan serta perbelanjaan individu atau isi rumah. Ini memerlukan kerjasama agensi kerajaan, sektor swasta dan masyarakat untuk mengumpul data tepat mengenai pendapatan dan perbelanjaan indi-vidu atau keluarga.

viou atau keluarga. Kesedaran dan pendidikan mengenai kepenti-ngan NDI sebagai pengukur kemiskinan juga pen-ting. Masyarakat perlu didedah cara menguruskan pendapatan dan perbelanjaan dengan lebih berkesan. Kerajaan juga perlu menyesuaikan dasar sedia ada untuk menyokong penggunaan NDI sebagai pengukur kemiskinan termasuk penyesuaian sistem cukai, sumbangan sosial dan program bantuan

tem cukai, sumbangan sosial dan program bantuan kewangan.
Secara keseluruhannya, penggunaan NDI sebagai pengganti PGK untuk mengukur kemiskinan di Malaysia adalah langkah positif dan berpotensi memberi gambaran lebih tepat mengenai kesejahteraan ekonomi rakyat. Berdasarkan pendekatan holistik dan bersepadu, usaha ini dapat membantu mengurangkan kemiskinan dan meningkatkan landiti dan gelonggan berpendanatan rendah

mengurangkan kemiskinan dari meringkatkan kualiti hidup golongan berpendapatan rendah. Melalui kerjasama pelbagai pihak dan penyesua-ian dasar sédia ada, penggunaan NDI sebagai pe-ngukur kemiskinan dapat dilaksana dengan ber-kesan dan memberi manfaat besar kepada rakyat.

## Ambil pengajaran global tadbir urus awam, swasta

Perkongsian Awam-Swasta (PPP) menjadi pendekatan strategik di seluruh dunia un-tuk memanfaatkan keupayaan sektor swasta dalam projek infrastruktur awam. Perkong-sian ini membolehkan kerajaan mengguna-kan pembiayaan dan kepakaran pengurusan sektor swasta untuk memenuhi keperluan infrastruktur

Pengalaman perintis awal seperti United Kingdom (UK) menawarkan pengajaran pen-ting untuk pembangunan model PPP lebih berkesan di seluruh dunia, termasuk di Malaysia. Selaras dengan pelaksanaan Pelan Induk Perkongsian Awam-Swasta 2030 (PI-Induk Perkongsian Awam-Swasta 2030 (PI-KAS 2030) dan pengumuman projek baharu dalam Bajet 2025, ada peluang untuk mengambil pengajaran daripada pengalaman antarabangsa bagi memperkukuh keberkesanan dan impak PPP di Malaysia.

Walaupun pelaksanaan projek melalui Inisiatif Pembiayaan Swasta (PFI) di UK pada awalnya menunjukkan kejayaan ketara, isu berkaitan kawalan kos, ketelusan dan kualiti perkhidmatan membawa kepada penilaian semula pendekatan mereka.

Penggunaan PPP secara besar-besaran di UK bermula pada 1992 di bawah PFI, bertujuan mengurangkan beban fiskal kerajaan

dengan membabitkan sektor swasta dalam pembangunan infrastruktur awam. Model ini, yang mana entiti swasta mereka bentuk, membiayai, membina dan mengendalikan aset awam dengan kerajaan menyewa aset ini melalui kontrak jangka panjang, menjadi terkenal dalam sektor seperti penjagaan kesihatan, pendidikan dan pengangkutan.

tan.
Namun, menjelang 2018, kebimbangan mengenai kos tinggi dan kontrak kaku muncul. Rangka kerja PPP Malaysia sedang berkembang di bawah PIKAS 2030, disokong langkah dalam Belanjawan 2025, bo-leh mengambil manfaat daripada memeriksa pengajaran antarabangsa ini untuk mengelakkan perangkap biasa dan memastikan kelestarian per-

Pengalaman daripada pelbagai projek PPP mene-kankan keperluan untuk pengurusan kewangan te-liti. Liabiliti tersembunyi, berpunca daripada su-sunan pembiayaan di luar kunci kira-kira, terbukti mahal di tempat lain. Pelaporan telus dan pera-kaunan akruan, seperti disyorkan PIKAS 2030 Ma-laysia dan diperkuatkan melalui inisiatif Belan-jawan 2025, boleh mengurangkan risiko itu dan meningkatkan keyakinan awam. Memastikan pembahagian keuntungan adil dan

meningkatkan Reyakulan awam.

Memastikan pembahagian keuntungan adil dan
menguruskan rundingan semula kontrak dengan
berkesan boleh mengelakkan keuntungan berlebihan sektor swasta merugikan manfaat awam.

Kontrak PPP ditadbir dengan baik dan boleh

disesuaikan dapat meminimumkan kekakuan dan ketidakcekapan seperti dilihat di tempat lain. Dengan menggalakkan ketelusan dan membolehkan rundingan semula apabila keperluan awam berkembang, Malaysia dapat meningkatkan daya tindak dan kejayaan projek PPP.

Kerajaan perlu memilih sektor di mana kepakaran sektor swasta memberi nilai tambah ketara untuk memaksimumkan hasil. Ini mungkin termasuk infrastruktur berasaskan teknologi, sementara model dipimpin awam mungkin lebih sesuai untuk sektor seperti penjagaan kesihatan dan pendidikan. didikan.

### Usaha MCMC pastikan daya tahan industri komunikasi an multimedia

Di negara ini, kebocoran data akibat kelemahan sistem keselamatan rangkaian komunikasi menjadi isu semakin mendesak, terutama dalam dunia digital semakin berkembang. Kebocoran data merujuk kejadian maklumat peribadi atau data penting dicuri, didedahkan atau disalahgunakan tanpa kebenaran menerusi pelbagai platform. Isu kebocoran data ini membabitkan pelbagai sektor termasuk awam, swasta dan perbankan. Ia turut menjejaskan tahap kepercayaan masyarakat serta keselamatan pada industri teknologi maklumat dan komunikasi (ICT). Beberapa kes kebocoran data pernah dilaporkan di Malaysia sehingga menimbulkan kebimbangan mengenai keselamatan maklumat peribadi, antaranya kebocoran data pengguna telefon bimbit pada 2017 dan kebocoran data lebih 200,000 pelanggan bank pada 2022 membabitkan butiran transaksi dan maklumat perbahak nesusitif.

Dalam hal ini, kerajaan sentiasa proaktif berusaha melindungi data peribadi orang ramai seperti memperkenalkan Akta Perlindungan Data Peribadi 2010 (PDPA) bagi melindungi maklumat perbadi individu, manakala Akta Kesalahan Komputer 1997 untuk menghukum mereka terbabit jenayah siber. Menyedari ancaman keselamatan digital ini, kerajaan menerusi Suruhanjaya Komunikasi dan Multimedia Malaysia (MCMC) meningkatkan penguatkuasaan terhadap syarikat telekomunikasi dan penyedia perkhidmatan bagi memastikan keselamatan data penguna.

Terkini, MCMC memperkenalkan Garis Panduan Keselamatan maklumat dan rangkaian seria daya tahan industri komunikasi dan multimedia (INSG) bagi meningkatkan keselamatan maklumat dan rangkaian seria daya tahan industri komunikasi dan multimedia di Malaysia.

UBSIDI secara pukal bagi petrol RON95 telah menjadi isu utama kerana perbelanjaan besar yang mencecah RM81 bilion pada tahun 2023.

Sebagai langkah mengurangkan beban fiskal negara, Perdana Menteri, Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim mengumumkan melalui Belanjawan 2025 bahawa golongan T15 atau mahakaya bakal dikenakan harga pasaran semasa bagi petrol RON95. Manakala 85 peratus daripada rakyat akan terus menikmati harga subsidi RM2.05 per-liter.

Menteri Ekonomi, Rafizi Ramli kemudiannya menjelaskan bahawa pengelasan subsidi ini akan didasarkan pada pendapatan bersih isi rumah berbanding pendapatan kasar bagi memastikan pengagihan yang lebih tepat.

Rentetan cadangan untuk menetapkan ambang pendapatan RM13,000 sebagai syarat kelayakan subsidi telah menimbulkan kebimbangan yang signifikan, khususnya di kawasan bandar seperti Kuala Lumpur, di mana kos sara hidup jauh lebih tinggi berbanding kawasan luar handar

Perbezaan ketara dalam kos perumahan, pengangkutan, pendidikan, dan barangan asas menyebabkan pendapatan isi rumah yang sama tidak memberikan kuasa beli yang setara di antara bandar dan luar bandar. Alhasil, keluarga bandar menghadapi cabaran kewangan yang lebih besar untuk menampung keperluan asas harian.

Sebagai contoh, sebuah keluarga di Kuala Lumpur mungkin perlu memperuntuk sebahagian besar pendapatan mereka untuk perumahan, yang biasanya berkali ganda lebih mahal ketimbang keluarga di kawasan luar

Selain itu, mereka turut dibebani kos penjagaan anak, pendidikan, dan perkhidmatan kesihatan yang lebih tinggi. Walaupun pendapatan mereka tampak setanding dengan keluarga di luar bandar, hakikatnya, kemampuan mereka untuk menabung, berbelanja, atau bahkan menampung keperluan harian adalah jauh lebih terhad.

#### FASA PENGURANGAN BERTAHAP

Isu utama dengan penetapan ambang RM13,000 adalah kesan pemotongan mendadak, di mana kenaikan pendapatan kecil sekalipun boleh menyebabkan sesebuah keluarga kehilangan subsidi sepenuhnya. Sistem seperti ini meletakkan beban yang tidak seimbang kepada mereka yang melebihi ambang pendapatan waima sedikit kerana mereka terpaksa menanggung kos yang sama seperti golongan berpendapatan tinggi meskipun tidak memiliki kemampuan kewangan yang setara.

Justeru, penyelesaian

yang lebih praktikal adalah melaksanakan pengurangan subsidi secara berperingkat. Melalui pendekatan ini, jumlah subsidi dikurangkan secara beransur-ansur selaras dengan peningkatan pendapatan dalam memastikan bantuan tidak dihentikan secara drastik. Sebagai contoh, isi rumah dengan pendapatan antara RM12,000 hingga RM15,000 masih layak menerima subsidi separa. Langkah sebegini membolehkan peralihan yang lebih lancar, sekali gus mengurangkan risiko kejutan kewangan kepada keluarga yang terlibat.

#### MENGAMBIL KIRA SAIZ KELUARGA DAN TANGGUNGAN

Selain itu, cadangan semasa juga mengabaikan faktor saiz keluarga, yang memainkan peranan penting dalam menentukan kos sara hidup. Isi rumah dengan bilangan tanggungan yang lebih ramai pastinya berdepan beban kewangan yang lebih tinggi berbanding isi rumah yang lebih kecil. Namun, ambang pendapatan yang ditetapkan tidak mengambil kira perbezaan ini, sekali gus menimbulkan kebimbangan mengenai keadilan dalam pelaksanaan subsidi.

Sebagai contoh, individu

bujang dengan pendapatan RM13,000 mempunyai lebihan pendapatan boleh guna yang jauh lebih besar berbanding sebuah keluarga dengan empat orang tanggungan yang mungkin perlu menanggung perbelanjaan tambahan, seperti kos rawatan kesihatan anak-anak. Namun, kedua-dua kategori ini tetap tidak layak menerima subsidi sekiranya pendapatan mereka melebihi RM13,000, tanpa mengambil kira perbezaan keperluan

#### MENGGUNAKAN DATA PENDAPATAN MASA NYATA

Kerajaan wajar mempertimbangkan penggunaan data pendapatan masa nyata untuk memastikan sistem subsidi lebih fleksibel dan responsif terhadap perubahan kewangan isi rumah. Penetapan ambang pendapatan statik seperti RM13,000 tidak mengambil kira turun naik pendapatan yang mungkin berlaku akibat pengangguran, krisis kesihatan, atau kesulitan kewangan lain. Keadaan ini berisiko menyebabkan keluarga terlepas daripada bantuan pada saat mereka paling memerlukannya.

Dengan memanfaatkan data pendapatan masa nyata, kerajaan boleh menyesuaikan kelayakan subsidi berdasarkan keadaan kewangan semasa isi rumah. Sebagai contoh, integrasi sistem subsidi dengan platform MyKad dapat menyediakan penilaian pendapatan yang lebih tepat dan terkini, memastikan bantuan diberikan kepada golongan yang benar-benar memerlukan.

Pendekatan ini telah terbukti berkesan melalui sistem Aadhaar di India, yang menggunakan teknologi digital untuk menyampaikan bantuan secara lebih efisien. Malaysia, dengan infrastruktur digital seperti MyKad, berada dalam kedudukan yang baik untuk melaksanakan sistem serupa yang mampu meningkatkan keberkesanan dan ketelusan agihan subsidi.

# Caj RM1 guna ATM: 15 juta pengguna berasa ditindas

PETALING JAYA: Persatuan pengguna mempersoalkan caj RM1 yang dikenakan untuk setiap transaksi di mesin pengeluaran automatik (ATM) yang disifatkan 'untung atas angin', sehingga syarikat pengendali mendapat untung berjuga-juta ringgit.

Presiden Persatuan Pengguna Kedah (Cake), Mohd. Yusrizal Yusoff berkata, caj yang dikenakan tidak memberikan manfaat yang jelas kepada 15 juta pengguna sehingga mereka berasa

ditindas.

"Dulu, kita menggunakan mesin ATM dan sistem antara bank tanpa dikenakan caj, tetapi tiada kerugian langsung dicatat oleh bank. Pada masa kini, syarikat ini mengenakan caj yang tidak rasional dan membebankan rakyat terutama golongan berpendapatan rendah.

"Kita yang keluar duit dan

"Kita yang keluar duit dan mereka yang dapat keuntungan sehingga berjuta-juta. Walaupun caj yang dikenakan hanya RM1 tetapi dengan kos sara hidup yang tinggi ia amat berharga bagi rakyat.

"Apa rasional caj RM1 terhadap pengguna sehingga mengaut untung atas angin.Kami beranggapan tidak rasional caj RM1 ini dan ia seperti menindas rakyat," katanya kepada Utusan Malaysia.

Tambahnya, jika mahu rakyat melibatkan diri dalam digitalisasi, ia perlu memudahkan mereka, bukan sebaliknya.

"Sekiranya kerajaan dan bank ingin menggalakkan rakyat menggunakan teknologi digital, mereka perlu menyediakan insentif seperti potongan harga atau pengurangan caj, bukannya menambah beban dengan caj tersembunyi yang membebankan golongan marhaen,"

Payments Network Malaysia Sdn. Bhd. (PayNet) dilaporkan memperoleh hasil sebanyak RM544 juta dan keuntungan RM271 juta daripada fi pengeluaran tunai RM1 di ATM.

Caj itu dilihat tidak munasabah kerana ia lebih menguntungkan syarikat tersebut.

tungkan syarikat tersebut. Pada 2023, PayNet meraih untung kasar RM544 juta dan untung bersih RM271 juta dan dilaporkan mengekalkan keuntungan terkumpul dari tahun terdahulu berjumlah RM1.43 bilion serta memiliki aset RM2.1 bilion.

Sehubungan itu, PayNet dan pemegang sahamnya termasuk BNM digesa memansuhkan fi pengeluaran tunai RM1 di ATM yang dilihat membebankan pelanggan, terutama golongan berpendapatan rendah.

Ini kerana, majoriti pelanggan terkesan dengan fi tersebut adalah daripada kumpulan berpendapatan rendah, termasuk sejumlah besar ahli kesatuan yang sedang bergelut memenuhi keperluan keluarga mereka.

uhi keperluan keluarga mereka.
Sementara itu, Setiausaha
Kesatuan Kebangsaan PekerjaPekerja Bank (NUBE), J Solomon
berkata, caj RM1 sudah membawa keuntungan hingga jutajutaan ringgit kepada pihak bank
tetapi menekan golongan B40.

Jelasnya, hanya pemilik akaun bank yang juga merupakan B40 sahaja menggunakan ATM dan golongan kaya pula menggunakan perbankan internet.

"Berjuta orang di Malaysia ini mempunyai akaun bank, daripada jumlah tersebut boleh dianggarkan 80 peratus adalah 840 dan M40. Itu sahaja kita sudah lihat berjuta orang yang menggunakan ATM serta terkesan dengan caj RM1 itu.

"Caj itu hanya menyebabkan orang kaya menjadi lebih kaya tetapi orang miskin terus menjadi miskin. Dalam kos kehidupan yang tinggi sekarang, RMI pun membawa tekanan kepada mereka," katanya. Tambahnya, kerajaan perlu

Tambahnya, kerajaan perlu membuat arahan kepada Bank Negara Malaysia (BNM) dan pihak bank lain bagi menghentikan caj perkhidmatan tersebut.

kan caj perkhidmatan tersebut.

"Apabila ATM itu diadakan di tempat-tempat yang boleh digunakan oleh pelanggan, sebenarnya pihak bank buat keuntungan daripada situ kerana mereka tidak perlu membayar gaji untuk pekerja dan sebagainya. Ini menyaksikan mereka meraih penjimatan.

"Tetapi mengapa pula pihak bank nak caj orang miskin RM1 lagi? Jika pihak mengatakan mereka perlu menanggung kos. Apa kosnya? Mereka sendiri menggalakkan pengguna menggunakan ATM," ujarnya.

Menurutnya, perbincangan sedang dilaksana dengan Menteri Wilayah Persekutuan Dr Zaliha Mustafa bagi
