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Arborist shortage in Selangor

ONLY four local councils in Selangor have accredited arborists, said state local government and tourism committee chairman Datuk Ng Suee Lim.

"Shah Alam City Council (MBSA), Sepang Municipal Council (MPSepang) and Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) each have an accredited arborist while Subang Jaya City Council (MBSJ) has two.

"This is a total of five accredited arborists in Selangor.

"The remaining eight out of 12 local authorities do not have any," he said during the state legislative assembly sitting in Shah Alam.

Ng added that Universiti Putra Malaysia had four arborists and Politeknik Sultan Salahuddin Abdul Aziz Shah had one.

Ng was replying to Lim Yi Wei (PH-Kampung Tunku) who asked the number of accredited arborists Selangor had as well as the government's plan to increase their numbers and ensure the sustainable maintenance of trees.

"To address this, the state will recommend sending local council staff such as landscape architects and agricultural officers from respective landscape departments to attend arborist certification courses.

"However, the number of participants and funds allocated for these courses will be determined by respective local councils," Ng said.

He was responding to a supplementary question by Lim on the number of targeted participants and funds allocation for the arborist certification courses.

Ng also said he would look into the suggestion by Dr Gunarajah R. George (PH-Sentosa) to seek advice from the National Landscape Department to set up a state-level Landscape Department.

There had been several cases of trees falling or branches snapping during storms in May, causing destruction to property.

On May 27, StarMetro reported that fallen trees had affected several areas under MBSJ's jurisdiction such as Jalan BK1/10 Pangsapuri Melur, Jalan BK9/5J, Jalan SP1/1, Jalan BK 8D, Jalan Wawasan 2/20 and Jalan Kinrara 6, BK6.

It was also reported on May 29 that three cars were damaged after a tree fell on them at Sri Kemboja Apartment in Bukit Sentosa, Hulu Selangor.

These cases had sparked calls by Selangor folk for better maintenance of greenery in urban areas.

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State to recommend sending staff from local councils for courses to increase numbers

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Tallest Ferris wheel draws many

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THRILLSEEKERS on the hunt for their next adventure should steer towards Gamuda Luge Gardens in Rawang, Selangor.

Spanning 16.8ha, the amusement park houses Malaysia's tallest theme park Ferris wheel.

Measuring over 50m high, the Ferris wheel has entered the *Malaysia Book of Records*.

The park also boasts five other rides as well as a skyline luge and waterplay area.

The rides are a turntable coaster, rotating gondola ride, suspended chair carousel, mini skydrop tower and a traditional carousel.

Built with a gross development value of RM949mil, the park is also equipped with several food and beverage outlets.

It is accessible via the North-South Expressway, Guthrie Corridor Expressway and Kuala Lumpur-Kuala Selangor Expressway (Latar).

Gamuda Bhd chairman Tan Sri Ambrin Buang said the park had received 420,000 visitors since its opening on Dec 9 last year.

"We are confident it will become the next tourism and entertainment hub in Klang Valley," he said at the park's launch.

Ambrin added that the park was an integral part of the company's placemaking approach to enhance the Gamuda Gardens township.

"We are guided by proper planning, integrating homes, parks, shopping, work and play spaces to create a

well-rounded community.

"This strategy has helped to transform our township into a vibrant place for the residents," he added.

Gamuda Land chief executive officer Chu Wai Lune said the park aimed to welcome 700,000 visitors a year.

The launch was also attended by Selangor Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Amirudin Shari and state local government and tourism committee chairman Datuk Ng Suee Lim.

During the launch, Amirudin said the park was the latest addition among many

attractions that awaited visitors to Selangor.

He expressed confidence that the state could secure seven million tourists this year, ahead of Visit Selangor Year 2025.

"Although Selangor lacks natural attractions like the ones in Langkawi in Kedah, and Mulu National Park in Sarawak, it has strengths in other areas.

"It is home to many theme parks and shopping centres that also tend to draw visitors both local and foreign," he said.

In 2023, Selangor surpassed its tourism target by nearly 50%, recording 4.5 mil-

lion domestic visitors, while the rest came from overseas.

Ng said the state government was in the midst of further developing its eco-tourism sector.

"We have identified several potential locations such as Sekinchan and Sabak Bernam to be turned into ecotourism spots," he added.

Also present at the event were Gamuda Land executive director Datuk Abdul Sahak Safi and Skyline Luge Kuala Lumpur operations manager Joshua Morris.

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WHEN The Sultan of Selangor's Cup (TSSC) annual match between Malaysia and Singapore last took place in 2019, no one foresaw the four-year hiatus that was to come.

Now that the football friendly is resuming, preparations for the 20th edition are in full swing.

stronger sense of atmosphere invigorating the match because we would be in such a historic place," he said.

Abd Karim encouraged match spectators to use public transport such as Mass Rapid Transit (MRT) and Light Rail Transit

(LRT) to avoid traffic jams.

"They have agreed to extend their operating hours to midnight," Abd Karim added, refer-

ring to MRT and LRT services.

Petaling Jaya mayor Mohamad Zahri Samington conveyed his full support for the iconic competition.

"We will also provide a bus departing from MBPJ for staff attending the match," he added.

At the MBPJ Civic Centre, 10 lucky draw winners won jerseys and TSSC tickets.

Match anticipation is building, with grandstand tickets now sold out.

As of July 9, only 1,500 normal seats at RM10 apiece remained.

Available tickets and jerseys will be next sold at Ampang Jaya Municipal Council (MPAJ) and Selayang Municipal Council (MPS) on July 15 and 22, respectively.

Tickets and jerseys will also be sold tomorrow at Tanjung Balai Group's Honda 4S Centre, Wisma Tanjung Balai in Seri Kembangan, Selangor.

Ticket and jersey buyers who come to the centre in any Honda car from 10am to noon stand a chance to receive a free 32-point inspection on a first-come, first-served basis.

Food operators turning to 'unlicensed' online traders

PETALING JAYA: Some food operators are turning to online traders, believed to be unlicensed, on ecommerce sites for essential cooking ingredients – namely rice and packaged cooking oil – to deal with rising costs of doing business.

The move has led to concerns of shortages as this is seen as traders "infringing" into consumers' supply of subsidised items.

Federation of Malaysian Consumers Association (Fomca) chief executive officer Saravanan Thambirajah said online sales of such items if not controlled could lead to shortages.

"We hope that the relevant

ministry takes action to curb this problem so that the sale of controlled items can be monitored.

"There must be a limit on purchases," he added.

Thambirajah said while enforcement was important, ecommerce platforms have to monitor the sale of controlled goods on their sites.

Bumiputra Retailers Organisation Malaysia president Datuk Ameer Ali Mydin said ecommerce platforms should also play a role in monitoring products sold on their platform.

"There should be no problem for retailers to sell their products whether online or offline, as long

as the rules are followed. The onus is on the sellers to make sure they are licensed to do so.

"At the same time, ecommerce platforms should also be controlled and online marketplaces must be responsible," said the Mydin managing director.

Checks by *The Star* on some ecommerce sites and a social media marketplace platform found several shops offering subsidised packaged cooking oil and local rice.

The sale of these items online has lured buyers, especially traders, to buy them at cheaper prices.

Petty Traders and Hawkers

Association president Datuk Rosli Sulaiman said his members complained that they had to fork out more than the price offered online.

"The members said that retailers would claim the stock had finished and instead offer a slightly higher priced product," he said.

Rosli said the association's members were left with no option but to pay the price as they were in need of cooking oil.

Pertubuhan Sahabat Tomyam Prihatin SeMalaysia adviser Che Mamad Che Mod has warned its members against any advertisements online that seem "too good

to be true".

"We understand that the cost of most materials is increasing.

"But as business operators, be careful not to fall into such traps," he said.

On July 3, the Domestic Trade and Cost of Living Ministry said that packaged cooking oil sales scams were taking place on social media and ecommerce sites where packaged cooking oil were being offered at cheaper than market prices.

It said the scammers were believed to have enticed victims through misleading advertisements on social media and ecommerce platforms.

Advancing Malaysia's commitment to women's rights

THE Women, Family and Community Development Ministry (KPWKM) has launched the Post-Constructive Dialogue Strategy for the Sixth Country Periodic Report of the Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination against Women (Cedaw).

The Post-Constructive Dialogue Strategy for Cedaw outlines actions for the empowerment and protection of women by each leading ministry and agency, aiming to align national legislation and policies with the convention's goal of eliminating discrimination against women.

Its minister, Datuk Seri Nancy Shukri, launched the strategy in Kuala Lumpur recently, with the Cedaw Working Committee

Meeting and Cedaw Appreciation Council.

According to a statement by KPWKM, the meeting followed the presentation of the Sixth Country Periodic Report of Cedaw at a Constructive Dialogue Session on May 19 in Geneva, Switzerland.

"The main objective of the meeting was to review all Cedaw Committee recommendations in the Concluding Observation document and appoint leading ministries and agencies to report on related achievements annually.

"All these recommendations have been incorporated into the Sixth Country Post-Constructive Dialogue Strategy on Cedaw which will be monitored annually," the statement read.

The ministry also announced that a Steering Committee and Cedaw Working Committee will be established, with meeting terms of reference to convene annually for each committee or as required.

Cedaw was adopted by the United Nations General Assembly on Dec 18, 1979 and came into force on Sept 3, 1981.

Malaysia acceded to Cedaw on July 5, 1995, with the understanding that its provisions do not conflict with the Federal Constitution and Syariah laws.

Cedaw's primary aim is to emphasise efforts to eliminate all forms of discrimination against women in political, economic, social and cultural domains. — Bernama

Raw water scheme contractor to be penalised for further delays

FURTHER delays to the Raw Water Security Scheme (SJAM) due to the fault of the contractor will not be tolerated by the Selangor government.

Penalties will be imposed if there are any more delays, said Selangor infrastructure and agriculture committee chairman Izham Hashim.

"The state had informed the contractor that no more extension will be considered after this.

"Instead, the contractor would need to pay a penalty to the state based on the terms in the contract," he said at the state assembly yesterday.

Michelle Ng (PH-Subang Jaya) questioned the status of the project and when it would be completed.

Izham said the project was supposed to be 91.16% completed but was delayed slightly

based on the timeline.

"The project is expected to be completed before the end of 2024 and will be surrendered to Air Selangor Sdn Bhd by the first quarter of 2025 after testing and commissioning," said Izham.

The four packages involved the supply, installation, testing and commissioning of pumping systems and other related works at Hybrid Off-River Augmentation System (Horas) 600 in Bestari Jaya, Kuala Selangor (Package A); Rantau Panjang Water Treatment Plant (WTP) in Kuala Selangor (Package B); Sungai Selangor Phase 1, 2 and 3 WTP in Bestari Jaya, Kuala Selangor (Package C); and Sungai Semenyih WTP in Jenderam Hilir (Package D).

Package A is 83.65% completed and is ahead of the planned completion timing.

This package is expected to be ready by the end of September with the installation of electricity and testing.

Package B's physical ground work is completed and is waiting for the installation of the electricity by the end of this month.

Package C is 95.04% completed and is expected to be fully completed by the end of July.

"However, the testing and commissioning process will take place together with the completion of Package A.

Meanwhile, Package D is facing a 6.23% delay.

"The reason for the delay is the contractor discovered an underground pipe that was not detected earlier.

"The pipe was discovered on May 16. It needs to be relocated first," he said.

The sitting ended *sine die*.

community, smart environment, and smart governance.

Theta group CEO Datuk Nuraslina Zainal Abidin said, "Theta has always been at the forefront of enabling innovation. This contract with MPAJ is a clear testament to our expertise in IoT technology and our dedication to fostering urban living through smart innovations. S'gor Islamic family law amendments to be tabled in 2026

SHAH ALAM: Amendments to the Selangor Islamic Family Law Enactment 2003 to include provisions for individuals or agents promoting marriages outside state Islamic laws are expected to be tabled in 2026.

State Islamic and Cultural Innovation Committee chairman Dr Mohammad Fahmi Ngah said the Selangor Islamic Religious Department is studying the amendments by adding clear provisions on the matter and proposing increased penalties for related offences, including abetting in efforts to address marriage syndicates.

"This year, seven out of 14 workshops planned by the department have been conducted with stakeholders, including the Selangor Syariah Judiciary Department and the Selangor Syariah Prosecution Department, with advice from State Chamber Office syariah officers, Selangor Islamic Religious Department legal officers and the Selangor Islamic Religious Council Legal Division Secretariat.

"Further planning will be brought for technical discussions by the council Legal Committee before

being presented at a council meeting and then tabled at the state legislative assembly in 2026."

He was responding to a question from Jefri Mejan (PN-Ijok) regarding efforts to address marriage syndicates abroad that were conducted without the Selangor Islamic Religious Department's permission at the state assembly sitting on Wednesday.

He said a marriage syndicate refers to a marriage that takes place abroad but is not registered under the Malaysian embassy, resulting in the

absence of a recognised marriage certificate, adding that there are currently no specific provisions regarding marriage syndicates in the Enactment.

However, he said legal provisions and enforcement under Section 124 (polygamy without court permission) and Section 40 (2) (offences related to marriage contracts) of the Enactment have been applied to curb offences in marriage syndicate activities.

"The penalties include a fine not exceeding RM1,000, up to six months' jail, or both." – Bernama

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Mechanism for adjusting civil servants' salaries out next month

THE mechanism for adjusting civil servants' salaries will be announced next month, coinciding with the launch of the Public Service Remuneration System (SSPA).

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department (Federal Territories) Dr Zaliha Mustafa said this in a parliamentary written reply on Wednesday.

She said the announcement would be made during the 19th Civil Service Premier Assembly.

"The Public Service Department will issue a service circular regarding the implementation of SSPA, which will explain the relevant mechanisms," she said in response to Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin (PN-Pagoh), who had asked for details of the salary adjustment mechanism, including the feasibility study and the additional resources estimated at RM10 billion to cover the pro-

jected increase in operating expenses.

During the Labour Day celebration on May 1, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Anwar Ibrahim had announced a more than 13 per cent increase in civil servants' remuneration, one of the highest in Malaysia's history.

This increase will be effective from Dec 1.

Anwar, who is also the finance minister, announced that the overall minimum pay for civil servants must exceed RM2,000.

Last year, the government pledged to introduce a new set of guidelines for the civil service salary scheme by the end of this year.

Emphasising the complexity of the process, Anwar said the salary alignment study, typically conducted every 10 years, required extensive coordination across various government departments.

'KING WANTS ACTION ON SOCIAL MEDIA MISUSE'

Ruler told about influencer's alleged suicide, says Fahmi

KUALA LUMPUR

HIS Majesty Sultan Ibrahim, King of Malaysia, has instructed the Communications Ministry and the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission (MCMC) to take stern action in addressing issues related to social media.

Communications Minister Fahmi Fadzil said Sultan Ibrahim had issued this directive during an audience at Istana Negara on Wednesday, where preparations for the king's installation ceremony on July 20 were discussed.

During the session, Fahmi also briefed Sultan Ibrahim on the case of a social media influencer who allegedly took her own life

following cyberbullying, in Gombak Setia, Selangor.

"After the formal discussion, His Majesty expressed concern over social media issues as he was informed of cyberbullying incidents," he said at the Parliament building here yesterday.

"His Majesty emphasised that the communications minister and MCMC must take firm action on this matter, reflecting his deep

concern," he added.

Fahmi said Sultan Ibrahim reiterated his message against the misuse of social media for arguments or shaming others, as such actions could sow division and conflict.

As such, he said the ministry, in collaboration with relevant agencies, would intensify efforts to ensure that social media remains a safe platform for all. **Bernama**

'Selasa bomba padam api, Khamis mereka bakar lagi'

Pengusaha *e-waste* haram ingkar arahan pihak berkuasa

Penduduk Kampung Sijangkang di sini mulai berang apabila pengusaha *e-waste* haram sekali lagi bertindak membakar sisa buangan bercampur plastik dan bahan binaan secara terbuka.

Tindakan demikian seolah-olah tidak mengendahkan amaran Jabatan Alam Sekitar (JAS), Majlis Perbandaran Kuala Langat (MPKL), malah pihak bomba dan penyelamat yang terpaksa memadamkan api bawah tanah berulang kali pada

Selasa lalu.

Wakil penduduk kampung yang hanya mahu dikenali sebagai Azrel berkata, plot tanah berukuran kira-kira dua hektar itu didakwa milik individu berbangsa Melayu dan menyewakannya kepada pengusaha *e-waste* haram tanpa menghiraukan impak aktiviti tersebut kepada komuniti setempat.

"Perkara ini tidak sepatutnya berlaku kerana premis terbabit sudah dikenakan amaran, kompaun dan dipasangkan papan tanda larangan oleh JAS.

"Hari ini (Khamis) mereka (pengusaha *e-waste* haram) bakar lagi di lokasi lain, namun dalam kawasan sama yang bomba dah padamkan api kelmarin.

"Betul-betul berani mereka ini, kalau begitu pihak berwajib perlu dapatkan info siapakah pemilik tanah Felcra yang sewakan kepada pengusaha," katanya ketika dihubungi pada Khamis.

2,000 individu di Selangor alami gangguan mental sejak 2020

SHAH ALAM - Kira-kira 2,000 hingga 3,000 individu tampil untuk mendapatkan rawatan berkenaan gangguan mental di klinik kesihatan di Selangor sejak empat tahun lalu.

Exco Kesihatan Awam dan Alam Sekitar Selangor, Jamaliah Jamaluddin berkata, bilangan kes mental adalah stabil dan jumlah yang meneruskan rawatan di klinik kesihatan dalam tempoh itu adalah lebih kurang sama.

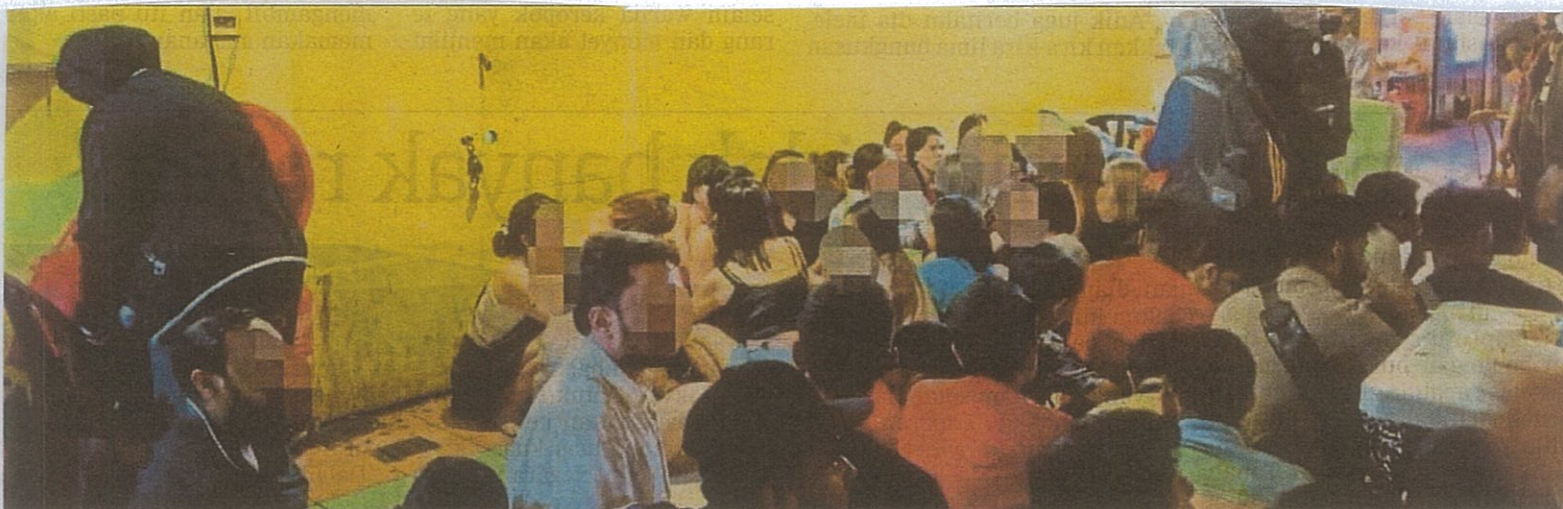

Malah, beliau menegaskan wakil PDRM, SPRM serta agensi lain yang menganggotai Jawatankuasa Tindakan Laporan Ketua Audit Negara (JTLKAN) bertanggungjawab untuk menyusul tindakan terhadap isu yang terbukti membabitkan salah guna kuasa, rasuah serta ketirisan.

tua pegawai eksekutif (CEO) yang mana agensi berkenaan dilaporkan dalam LKAN, akan dijemput menemui jawatankuasa ini bagi memberi penjelasan mengenai isu yang dibangkitkan dalam laporan terbabit.

"Dalam mesyuarat ini, SPRM, PDRM, JPA dan agensi lain akan mengesan isu di bawah pengawasan masing-masing dan akan membuka fail siasatan mengikut kewajaran dan keseriusan sesuatu isu terbabit.
